Amendment No. 17 316.07456 Grandfather clause.--18 (1) Any traffic infraction detector deployed on the 19 streets and highways of the state must meet the contract 20 specifications established by the Department of Transportation 21 and must be tested at regular intervals according to procedures 22 prescribed by that department. 23 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 24 prior to September 30, 2010, nothing in this act shall prohibit 25 any county or municipality from utilizing red light traffic 26 enforcement devices of any type or from enforcing violations of 27 s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c) or other red light traffic 28 enforcement ordinances if such county or municipality has 29 enacted an ordinance to enforce red light violations or has entered into a contract to purchase or lease equipment to 30 31 enforce red light violations prior to the effective date of this 32 act. 33 (3) Counties and municipalities using grandfathered 34 equipment pursuant to subsection (2) shall charge violators a 35 \$150 penalty. One-fifth of the penalty shall be remitted by the 36 county or municipality to the Department of Revenue for deposit 37 into the State Transportation Trust Fund, one-fifth shall be 38 remitted to the Department of Revenue for deposit into the 39 Department of Health Administrative Trust Fund, and three-fifths 40 shall be retained by the county or municipality.
