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Section 4. Section 768.0985, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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768.0985 Limitation of liability for employers of persons with disabilities.--

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(1) An employer employing a person with a developmental disability as defined in s. 393.063 is not liable for the acts or omissions, negligent or intentional, of the employee, if:

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(a) The employee has received supported employment services through a public or private not-for-profit provider; and

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(b) The employer does not have actual notice of actions of the employee which create unsafe conditions in the workplace.

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(2) A not-for-profit supported employment service provider that has provided supported employment services to an individual with a disability, as defined in s. 393.063, shall not be liable for the actions or conduct of the individual occurring within the scope of such individual's employment.
