22	$rac{\$85}{}$ in filing fees, $rac{\$120}{\$80}$ must be remitted by the clerk to

One-third of 29 30 any filing fees collected by the clerk of the circuit court in 31 excess of \$140 \$100 shall be remitted to the Department of 32 Revenue for deposit into the Department of Revenue Clerks of the 33 Court Trust Fund. An additional filing fee of \$4 shall be paid 34 to the clerk. The clerk shall remit \$3.50 to the Department of 35 Revenue for deposit into the Court Education Trust Fund and 36 shall remit 50 cents to the Department of Revenue for deposit 37 into the Department of Financial Services Administrative Trust 38 Fund to fund clerk education. The Clerk of the Court Operations Corporation shall reduce the individual approved 81 budgets of the clerks of court to ensure that the sum of the 82 83 approved budgets does not exceed this statewide budget cap. 84 Section 4.
