HB 607 2009

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Pinellas Park Water Management District, Pinellas County; repealing chapter 2001-325, Laws of Florida; providing for drainage system maintenance; abolishing the Pinellas Park Water Management District; transferring all assets and liabilities of the district; providing for a referendum; providing effective dates.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Effective October 1, 2011, chapter 2001-325,</u>

<u>Laws of Florida, is repealed, and the Pinellas Park Water</u>

Management District is abolished.

Section 2. <u>Upon dissolution of the district</u>, responsibility for maintaining the drainage system shall be transferred to the Town of Kenneth City, the City of Pinellas Park, the City of St. Petersburg, and Pinellas County. Each entity shall be responsible for maintaining the drainage infrastructure within its geographic boundaries, or according to an interlocal agreement that may be created for this purpose.

Section 3. Upon dissolution of the district, any district assets and liabilities shall be divided among the Town of Kenneth City, the City of Pinellas Park, the City of St.

Petersburg, and Pinellas County according to their current proportion in the district or according to an interlocal agreement that may be created for this purpose.

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Section 4. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect only upon its approval by a majority vote of the electors of the Pinellas Park Water Management District voting in a referendum election to be held at the next regular primary or general election or at a special election called by the Board of County Commissioners and the City Council of Pinellas Park, except that this section shall take effect upon becoming a law.
