The Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Haridopolos) recommended the following:

The notice shall, and specify that the purpose for the public meeting is to consider whether it is in the public's best interest to perform the project using the local government's own services, employees, and equipment. Upon publication of the public notice and for 21 days thereafter, the local government shall make available for public inspection during normal business hours at a location specified in the public notice a detailed itemization of each component of the estimated cost of the project and documentation explaining the methodology used to arrive at the estimated cost. At the public meeting, any qualified contractor or vendor who might have been awarded the project if the project had been competitively bid shall be provided with a reasonable opportunity to present
