(b) The supervisor shall also designate any city hall as an early voting site. The supervisor may also designate any permanent public library facility or any polling place to be used on election day as an early voting site. In any general election in which a candidate for President of the United States appears on the ballot, the supervisor of elections shall designate at least one early voting site for every 40,000 registered voters within the county. In any general election in which a candidate for President of the United States does not appear on the ballot, the supervisor shall designate at least one early voting site for every 80,000 registered voters within the county. To the extent practicable, the designated sites must 856085

The results or tabulation of votes cast during early voting may not be made before the close of the polls on election day. Results shall be reported by precinct.
