- (8) PENALTIES.—In addition to any other penalty provided in the Beverage Law, the division may suspend or revoke a winery shipper license or impose fines on the winery shipper licensee for any violation of this section.
- (a) A winery shipper licensee that ships, or causes to be shipped, wine to any person in this state who is under 21 years of age commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as



provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

- (b) Any common carrier, permit carrier, or other commercial conveyance that delivers wine directly to any person in this state who is under 21 years of age commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (c) A person who obtains wine from a winery shipper licensee in violation of this section commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
