The institute, through its partner institutions, shall support research focus areas including, but not limited to, spaceport licensing and safety; range and airspace management systems development, simulation, and qualification; spaceflight human

factors issues; spaceflight passenger, crew, and technician training and certification; launch vehicle safety analysis; materials science for spaceflight; spaceport instrumentation, technologies, and processes; and other topics which may be of interest to the Federal Aviation Administration.

(2) The institute shall be established in phases, with the initial phase focused on developing a management structure, establishing a formal relationship with the Federal Aviation Administration, and forming partnerships with academic institutions and industry. The institute shall provide a quarterly report to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development on the institute's activities, relationship status with the Federal Aviation Administration, research, and partnerships. Any monies provided by government or private industry directly to Embry Riddle Aeronautical University or the Florida Institute of Technology shall not be a part of the Institute but shall remain as an allocation as intended for each institution.
