20	1. Three shall represent counties with fewer than 75,000
21	registered voters and shall be selected by supervisors from
22	within that group.
23	2. Three shall represent counties with at least 75,000 but
24	no more than 200,000 registered voters and shall be selected by
25	supervisors from within that group.
26	3. Three shall represent counties with more than 200,000
27	registered voters and shall be selected by supervisors from
28	within that group.
29	(3) The members of the task force shall elect a chair and a

30	vice chair from among its membership. The chair shall preside at
31	all meetings of the task force.
32	(4) The task force shall meet at the call of the chair or
33	at the request of a majority of its membership.

36	House of Representatives, and the President of the Senate no
37	later than November 30, 2009.
