**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

and insert:

(1) The commission may adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 designating eligible appliances, rebate amounts, and the administration of the issuance of rebates. The rules shall be consistent with 42 U.S.C. s. 15821 and any subsequent implementing federal regulations or guidance.

(2) The commission is authorized to enter into contracts or memoranda of agreement with other agencies of the state, public-



13 private partnerships, or other arrangements such that the most  
14 efficient means of administering consumer rebates can be  
15 achieved.

16 Section 2. For the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the sum of  
17 \$150,000 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the  
18 Florida Energy and Climate Commission for the purpose of  
19 administering the energy-efficient appliance rebate program;  
20 however, the funds shall not be released to the commission until  
21 it has submitted a report to the Legislative Budget Commission  
22 certifying that the energy-efficient appliance rebate program  
23 complies with 42 U.S.C. s. 15821 and any subsequent implementing  
24 federal regulations and that the state will receive funds  
25 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. s. 15821 and the American Recovery and  
26 Reinvestment Act of 2009 to implement the energy-efficient  
27 appliance rebate program.
