

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to state park designations; redesignating
 3 Grayton Beach State Park as Bob Graham/Grayton Beach State
 4 Park; designating the Jack Mashburn Marina within St.
 5 Andrew's State Park; directing the Division of Recreation
 6 and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection to
 7 erect appropriate signs and markers; providing an
 8 effective date.

 10 WHEREAS, Bob Graham's roots in Walton County go back for
 11 generations, and

12 WHEREAS, in the 1890s, Bob Graham's grandfather, Dr. Daniel
 13 Simmons, opened a medical practice in Freeport, and

14 WHEREAS, Bob Graham's mother and her five siblings were
 15 born in Walton County and his mother graduated from Walton
 16 County High School in 1924, and

17 WHEREAS, in 1985, as Governor, Bob Graham strongly
 18 supported the efforts of the residents of Walton County to
 19 encourage the state to purchase the beachfront and the dunes and
 20 forest land adjacent to Grayton Beach State Park, and

21 WHEREAS, this valuable addition to the park might never
 22 have occurred without Bob Graham's personal involvement, and

23 WHEREAS, Bob Graham, as a former United States Senator,
 24 Governor, State Senator, and State Representative for Florida,
 25 is recognized as one of the state's most popular political
 26 leaders and environmental policy advocates, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. Bob Graham/Grayton Beach State Park designation.—

(1) Grayton Beach State Park is redesignated as the Bob Graham/Grayton Beach State Park.

(2) The Division of Recreation and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection is directed to erect appropriate signs and markers designating the Bob Graham/Grayton Beach State Park as described in subsection (1).

Section 2. Jack Mashburn Marina designation.—

(1) The marina at Grand Lagoon within St. Andrew's State Park, commonly referred to as the "boat basin," is designated as the Jack Mashburn Marina.

(2) The Division of Recreation and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection is directed to erect appropriate signs and markers designating the Jack Mashburn Marina as described in subsection (1).

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
