30 (b) The first \$500,000 of annual use fees shall be 31 deposited in the Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund in the 32 Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and shall be used by 33 the Florida Marine Turtle Protection Program to conduct sea turtle protection, research, and recovery programs. The next 34 35 \$215,000 in annual use fees shall be distributed to the 36 Caribbean Conservation Corporation to fund sea turtle research 37 and education programs. The Caribbean Conservation Corporation 38 shall annually distribute assigned funds through a Sea Turtle 39 Grants Program that supports sea turtle research and education activities of Florida-based nonprofit groups, education and 40 research institutions, and coastal counties in this state. 57 additional annual revenue shall be distributed as follows: 70 58 percent shall be deposited in the Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund and used by the Florida Marine Turtle Protection 59 60 Program for sea turtle conservation activities and 30 percent 61 shall be assigned to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation for 62 distribution through the Sea Turtle Grants Program. From the funds distributed to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation, an 63 64 amount not to exceed 10 percent of the total annual revenue from 65 the sale of the plate may be used for marketing the Sea Turtle 66 license plate and for administrative costs directly associated 67 with the grants program.
