A felony of the third degree is reclassified to a 25 felony of the second degree. 26 4. A felony of the second degree is reclassified to a 27 felony of the first degree. 28 5. 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29 felony. 30 (b) As used in paragraph (a), the term: "Mental or physical disability" means that the victim 31 1. suffers from a condition of physical or mental incapacitation 32 33 due to a developmental disability, organic brain damage, or 34 mental illness, and has one or more physical or mental 35 limitations that restrict the victim's ability to perform the 36 normal activities of daily living. 37 2. "Advanced age" means that the victim is older than 65 38 years of age. 39 3. "Homeless status" means that the victim: a. Lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime 40 41 residence; or 42 b. Has a primary nighttime residence that is: 43 (I) A supervised publicly or privately operated shelter 44 designed to provide temporary living accommodations; or 45 (II) A public or private place not designed for, or 46 ordinarily used as, a regular sleeping accommodation for human 47 beings. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2010. 48

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
