Section 6. The Legislature recognizes that due to varying local conditions, local governments have different planning needs that cannot be addressed by a uniform set of minimum planning criteria. Therefore, the state land planning agency may amend chapter 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code, to establish different minimum reporting criteria that are applicable to small or fiscally constrained local governments and may establish a waiver provision to satisfy ongoing reporting requirements if no significant changes occur, based upon the
