The Committee on Higher Education Appropriations (Thrasher) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

5 (2) A student who is enrolled in a program that terminates 6 in an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree may receive an 7 award for a maximum of 110 percent of the number of credit hours 8 required to complete the program. A student who is enrolled in a 9 program that terminates in a career certificate may receive an 10 award for a maximum of 110 percent of the credit hours or clock hours required to complete the program up to 90 credit hours. 11 However, for a student who is initially funded in the 2010-2011 12

14	100 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete

18	hours of a program that terminates in a career certificate. A
19	student who transfers from one of these program levels to
20	another becomes eligible for the higher of the two credit hour
