Senator Dean moved the following:

1 **Senate Amendment to Amendment (679954) (with title**

4 Delete lines 25 - 79

5 and insert:

6 Special Facility Construction Committee. No district shall
7 receive funding for more than one approved project in any 3-year
8 period. The first year of the 3-year period shall be the first
9 year a district receives an appropriation. The department shall
10 encourage a construction program that reduces the average size
11 of schools in the district. The request must meet the following
12 criteria to be considered by the committee:

- 13 1. The project must be deemed a critical need and must be



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14 recommended for funding by the Special Facility Construction
15 Committee. Prior to developing plans for the proposed facility,
16 the district school board must request a preapplication review
17 by the Special Facility Construction Committee or a project
18 review subcommittee convened by the committee to include two
19 representatives of the department and two staff from school
20 districts not eligible to participate in the program. Within 60
21 days after receiving the preapplication review request, the
22 committee or subcommittee must meet in the school district to
23 review the project proposal and existing facilities. To
24 determine whether the proposed project is a critical need, the
25 committee or subcommittee shall consider, at a minimum, the
26 capacity of all existing facilities within the district as
27 determined by the Florida Inventory of School Houses; the
28 district's pattern of student growth; the district's existing
29 and projected capital outlay full-time equivalent student
30 enrollment as determined by the department; the district's
31 existing satisfactory student stations; the use of all existing
32 district property and facilities; grade level configurations;
33 and any other information that may affect the need for the
34 proposed project.

35 2. The construction project must be recommended in the most
36 recent survey or surveys conducted and approved by the Office of
37 Educational Facilities, in cooperation with ~~by~~ the district,
38 under the rules of the State Board of Education.

39 3. The construction project must appear on the district's
40 approved project priority list under the rules of the State
41 Board of Education.

42 4. The district must have selected and had approved a site



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43 for the construction project in compliance with s. 1013.36 and
44 the rules of the State Board of Education.

45 5. The district shall have developed a district school
46 board adopted list of facilities that do not exceed the norm for
47 net square feet occupancy requirements under the State
48 Requirements for Educational Facilities, using all possible
49 programmatic combinations for multiple use of space to obtain
50 maximum daily use of all spaces within the facility under
51 consideration.

52 6. Upon construction, the total cost per student station,
53 including change orders, must not exceed the cost per student
54 station as provided in subsection (6).

55 7. There shall be an agreement signed by the district
56 school board stating that it will advertise for bids within 30
57 days of receipt of its encumbrance authorization from the
58 department.

59 8. The district shall, at the time of the request and for a
