

Senate Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between lines 2092 and 2093

insert:

(12) (a) No license issued pursuant to this section shall 6 authorize any person to carry a concealed weapon or firearm into 7 any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05; any police, 8 sheriff, or highway patrol station; any detention facility, 9 prison, or jail; any courthouse; any courtroom, except that nothing in this section would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her courtroom; any polling place; any meeting of the governing body of a county, public school district, 13

14 municipality, or special district; any meeting of the 15 Legislature or a committee thereof; any school, college, or professional athletic event not related to firearms; any school 16 administration building; any portion of an establishment 17 18 licensed to dispense alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, which portion of the establishment is primarily 19 20 devoted to such purpose; any elementary or secondary school facility; any career center; any college or university facility 21 22 unless the licensee is a registered student, employee, or 23 faculty member of such college or university and the weapon is a 24 stun gun or nonlethal electric weapon or device designed solely 25 for defensive purposes and the weapon does not fire a dart or projectile; inside the passenger terminal and sterile area of 26 27 any airport, provided that no person shall be prohibited from carrying any legal firearm into the terminal, which firearm is 28 29 encased for shipment for purposes of checking such firearm as 30 baggage to be lawfully transported on any aircraft; or any place where the carrying of firearms is prohibited by federal law. Any 31 32 person who willfully violates any provision of this subsection 33 commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as 34 provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

35 (b) Nothing shall prohibit or restrict a person licensed 36 under this section from transporting or storing, for lawful 37 purposes, a lawful firearm in a private vehicle wherever the 38 vehicle is otherwise lawfully present.

39 <u>(c) This subsection does not modify the terms or conditions</u> 40 <u>of s. 790.251(7).</u> 41
