(3) (a) The inspector general <u>of each state agency</u> shall be appointed by the agency head <u>and confirmed by the Senate</u>. For agencies under the direction of the Governor, the appointment shall be made after notifying the Governor and the Chief Inspector General in writing, at least 7 days <u>before</u> <del>prior to</del> an offer of employment, of the agency head's intention to hire the inspector general.

30 <u>(a) (b)</u> Each inspector general shall report to and be under 31 the general supervision of the agency head and <u>is shall</u> not <del>be</del> 32 subject to supervision by any other employee of the state 33 agency. The inspector general shall be appointed without regard 34 to political affiliation.
