Beginning January 1, 2002, no 19 facility shall staff below one certified nursing assistant per 20 20 residents, and a minimum licensed nursing staffing of 1.0 21 2.2 hour of direct care per resident per day but never below one 23 licensed nurse per 40 residents.

24 d.b. Beginning July 1, 2011 January 1, 2007, a minimum 25 weekly average certified nursing assistant staffing of 2.9 hours 26 of direct care per resident per day. For the purpose of this sub-subparagraph, a week is defined as Sunday through Saturday.
