4 Between lines 1833 and 1834, insert:

5 Section 31. Paragraph (i) is added to subsection (3) of  
6 section 499.01212, Florida Statutes, to read:

7 499.01212 Pedigree paper.—

8 (3) EXCEPTIONS.—A pedigree paper is not required for:

9 (i) The wholesale distribution of prescription drugs  
10 within a medical convenience kit if:

11 1. The medical convenience kit is assembled in an  
12 establishment that is registered with the United States Food and  
13 Drug Administration as a medical device manufacturer;

14 2. The medical convenience kit manufacturer is an  
15 authorized distributor of record, as defined by 21 C.F.R. s.

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16 203.3, for the manufacturer of the specific drugs contained  
17 within the kit; and

18 3. The drugs contained in the medical convenience kit are:

19 a. Intravenous solutions intended for the replenishment of  
20 fluids and electrolytes;

21 b. Products intended to maintain the equilibrium of water  
22 and minerals in the body;

23 c. Products intended for irrigation or reconstitution;

24 d. Anesthetics; or

25 e. Anticoagulants.

27 This paragraph does not apply to a medical convenience kit  
28 containing any controlled substance that appears in any schedule  
29 contained in or subject to chapter 893 or the Federal  
30 Comprehensive Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Act of 1970.
