Section 4. Section 284.51, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

284.51 Public employer workplace safety.-

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "OSHA" means the Occupational Safety and Health Administration of the United States Department of Labor.

(b) "Public employer" means any agency within the state, a county, or a municipal government, including a school district,

13 which employs individuals for salary, wages, and other
14 remuneration.

15 (2) Effective June 30, 2013, all public employers must
16 comply with OSHA general industry standards described in 29
17 C.F.R. 1910, and construction standards as described in 29
18 C.F.R. 1926, as applicable.

19 (3) The department shall annually report the injury and
20 illness data for public employers in the aggregate as well as on
21 a per-public-employer basis. The department shall publish the
22 report on its website.

23 (4) Effective October 1, 2010, the department shall
24 establish and publicize a website through which public employers
25 and employees can access information related to workplace
26 safety.
