A bill to be entitled

An act relating to postsecondary tuition; providing a short title; creating s. 1009.295, F.S.; requiring the student catalog, application packet, and fee invoice to separately identify tuition and all fees required by each public postsecondary institution; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Transparency in Tuition Act."

Section 2. Section 1009.295, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1009.295 Tuition transparency.

- (1) The student catalog and application packet for each public postsecondary institution in this state must provide a current tuition and fees schedule for residents and nonresidents which separately identifies the tuition, out-of-state fee, and each additional required fee authorized under this chapter, plus a list of optional fees, for each level of coursework offered. The catalog and application packet must also provide a statement describing the proportion of the full, per student, instructional cost that is covered by tuition and fees. The catalog and application packet containing this information must be posted on each institution's website.
- (2) Each fee invoice submitted to a student for payment by a public postsecondary institution in this state must provide an itemized list that separately identifies the tuition, out-of-
