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The Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations (Dockery) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Delete lines 286 - 341

and insert:

402.281 Gold Seal Quality Care program.-

(1) (a) There is established within the department the Gold Seal Quality Care Program.

8 (b) A child care <u>facility</u> facilities, large family child 9 care <u>home</u> homes, or family day care <u>home</u> homes that <u>is</u> are 10 accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting association 11 <u>approved by the department under subsection (3) and meets all</u> 12 other requirements shall, upon application to the department,

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13	whose standards substantially meet or exceed the National
14	Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the
15	National Association of Family Child Care, and the National
16	Early Childhood Program Accreditation Commission shall receive a
17	separate "Gold Seal Quality Care" designation to operate as a
18	gold seal child care facility, large family child care home, or
19	family day care home.
20	(2) The department shall adopt rules establishing Gold Seal
21	Quality Care accreditation standards based on the applicable
22	accrediting standards of the National Association for the
23	Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the National Association of
24	Family Child Care, and the National Early Childhood Program
25	Accreditation Commission.
26	(3) (a) In order to be approved by the department for
27	participation in the Gold Seal Quality Care program, an
28	accrediting association must apply to the department and
29	demonstrate that it:
30	1. Is a nationally recognized accrediting association.
31	2. Has accrediting standards that substantially meet or
32	exceed the Gold Seal Quality Care standards adopted by the
33	department under subsection (2).
34	(b) In approving accrediting associations, the department
35	shall consult with the Department of Education, the Agency for
36	Workforce Innovation, the Florida Head Start Directors
37	Association, the Florida Association of Child Care Management,
38	the Florida Family Day Care Association, the Florida Children's
39	Forum, the Early Childhood Association of Florida, the Child
40	Development Education Alliance, providers receiving exemptions
41	under s. 402.316, and parents.
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42 (2) In developing the Gold Seal Quality Care program 43 standards, the department shall consult with the Department of Education, the Florida Head Start Directors Association, the 44 45 Florida Association of Child Care Management, the Florida Family 46 Day Care Association, the Florida Children's Forum, the State Coordinating Council for School Readiness Programs, the Early 47 Childhood Association of Florida, the National Association for 48 49 Child Development Education, providers receiving exemptions under s. 402.316, and parents, for the purpose of approving the 50 51 accrediting associations.

52 <u>(4)</u> (3) In order to obtain and maintain a designation as a 53 Gold Seal Quality Care provider, a child care facility, large 54 family child care home, or family day care home must meet the 55 following additional criteria:

(a) The child care provider must not have had any class I
violations, as defined by rule, within the 2 years preceding its
application for designation as a Gold Seal Quality Care
provider. Commission of a class I violation shall be grounds for
termination of the designation as a Gold Seal Quality Care
provider until the provider has no class I violations for a
period of 2 years.

63 (b) The child care provider must not have had three or more class II violations, as defined by rule, within the 2 years 64 65 preceding its application for designation as a Gold Seal Quality 66 Care provider. Commission of three or more class II violations 67 within a 2-year period shall be grounds for termination of the 68 designation as a Gold Seal Quality Care provider until the provider has no class II violations for a period of 1 year. 69 70 (c) The child care provider must not have been cited for

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71	the same class III violation, as defined by rule, three or more
72	times within the 2 years preceding its application for
73	designation as a Gold Seal Quality Care provider. Commission of
74	the same class III violation three or more times during a 2-year
75	period shall be grounds for termination of the designation as a
76	Gold Seal Quality Care provider until the provider has no class
77	III violations for a period of 1 year.
78	(5)(4) The Department of Children and Family Services shall
79	adopt rules under ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 which provide
80	criteria and procedures for reviewing and approving accrediting
81	associations for participation in the Gold Seal Quality Care
82	program, conferring and revoking designations of Gold Seal
83	Quality Care providers, and classifying violations.
