Section 2. Section 284.51, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 284.51 Public employer workplace safety.--
- (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "OSHA" means the Occupational Safety and Health Administration in the United States Department of Labor.
- (b) "Public employer" means any agency within state, county, or municipal government, including a school district, that employs individuals for salary, wages, or other remuneration.
- (2) Effective June 30, 2013, all public employers must comply with OSHA general industry standards provided in C.F.R. 015691

part 1910 and construction standards provided in C.F.R. part 1926, as applicable.

- (3) The Department of Financial Services shall annually report the injury and illness data for public employers in aggregate as well as on a per-public-employer basis. Such report shall also be published on the department's website.
- (4) Effective October 1, 2010, the Department of Financial Services shall establish and publicize a website for public employers and employees to access information related to workplace safety.
- (5) The Legislature finds that this section fulfills an important state interest.
