626.869 License, adjusters; continuing education.-

(6) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, independent adjusters and insurance adjusters must go through an apprenticeship under which they shall complete a minimum of 8 hours of continuing education specific to the practice of serving as an independent adjuster or insurance adjuster, 4 hours of which must relate to ethics, in order to qualify for licensure as an independent or insurance adjuster. The continuing education must be in subjects designed to inform the licensee regarding the current insurance laws of this state for
