Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 218 and 219 insert:

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Section 3. Subsection (4) of section 627.0613, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

627.0613 Consumer Advocate.—The Chief Financial Officer must appoint a consumer advocate who must represent the general public of the state before the department and the office. The consumer advocate must report directly to the Chief Financial Officer, but is not otherwise under the authority of the

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department or of any employee of the department. The consumer advocate has such powers as are necessary to carry out the duties of the office of consumer advocate, including, but not limited to, the powers to:

- (4) By June 1, 2012, and each June 1 thereafter, prepare an annual report card for each authorized personal residential property insurer, on a form and using a letter-grade scale developed by the commission by rule, which objectively grades each insurer based on the following factors:
- (a) The number and nature of valid consumer complaints, as a market share ratio, received by the department against the insurer.
- (b) The disposition of all valid complaints received by the department.
- (c) The average length of time for payment of claims by the insurer.
- (d) Any other measurable and objective factors the commission identifies as capable of assisting policyholders in making informed choices about homeowner's insurance.
