Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 648 and 649
insert:

Section 17. In an effort to reduce fraud with this state's Medicaid program, the Agency for Health Care Administration shall implement a statewide, comprehensive utilization management program for the disposable of medical supplies. This program shall be used by all Medicaid State Plan recipients, including recipients enrolled in home and community-based Medicaid waiver programs. The program shall require registered nurse assessments and consultants; real-time eligibility determination; shipment tracking utilization management; and



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14 customer call center assistance. This section does not apply to
15 beneficiaries enrolled in a prepaid, capitated managed care
16 plan. The Agency for Health Care Administration shall issue a
17 competitive bid to select qualified organizations to provide
18 this utilization management program. The Agency for Health Care
19 Administration may seek federal waivers to implement this
20 initiative.
