381.986 Screening for autism spectrum disorder and other developmental disabilities.-

(1) If the parent or legal guardian of a minor believes that the minor exhibits symptoms of autism spectrum disorder or other developmental disability, the parent or legal guardian may report his or her observation to a physician licensed in this state. The physician shall immediately refer the minor to an appropriate specialist for further screening and diagnosis. This



section does not apply to a physician providing care under s. 395.1041. (2) As used in this section, the term "appropriate specialist" means a qualified professional who is experienced in the evaluation of autism spectrum disorder or other developmental disabilities, is licensed in this state, and has training in validated diagnostic tools.
