28	CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTINGContiguous single-member districts
29	shall be drawn to: (1) equalize population, (2) respect
30	communities of common interests, (3) not deny citizen rights to
31	express favor or disfavor for incumbents or political parties,
32	and (4) not deny or diminish opportunities for racial or
33	language minorities to elect candidates they choose. Giving
34	priority to these requirements, the Legislature shall balance
35	and apply all constitutional standards for redistricting.
