STANDARDS FOR THE LEGISLATURE TO FOLLOW IN LEGISLATIVE AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING.—Contiguous single-member districts shall be drawn to: (1) equalize population, (2) respect communities of common interests, (3) not deny citizen rights to express favor or disfavor for incumbents or political parties, and (4) not deny or diminish opportunities for racial or language minorities to elect candidates they choose. Districts are valid if drawn in a way that is rationally related to standards in the State Constitution and consistent with federal law.
