5 (10) "Main-traveled way" means the traveled way of a 6 highway on which through traffic is carried. In the case of a 7 divided highway, the traveled way of each of the separate 8 roadways for traffic in opposite directions is a main-traveled 9 way. It does not include such facilities as frontage roads, 10 turning roadways, <u>which specifically includes on or off ramps to</u> 11 <u>the interstate highway system</u>, or parking areas.
