(b) The governing body of a county or municipality enacting an ordinance relating to animal control or cruelty shall may impose and collect a surcharge of \$15 up to \$5 upon each civil penalty imposed for each violation of the an ordinance relating to animal control or cruelty. One dollar of the surcharge may be retained by the clerk of the court, \$5 of the surcharge proceeds from such surcharges shall be used to pay the costs of training for animal control officers, and the remainder of the surcharge shall be used to subsidize the costs of spaying or neutering of dogs and cats whose owners voluntarily submit their animals for sterilization. Owners of such animals may not be charged more for the spaying or neutering than the cost of sterilization less
