(1) The department is responsible for developing the specialty license plates authorized in s. 320.08053. The

16	(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be

21	(b) The department is authorized to discontinue the
22	issuance of a specialty license plate and distribution of

26	the organization does not meet the presale requirements as
27	prescribed in s. 320.08053(3), or pursuant to an organizational
28	recipient's request. Organizations <u>shall</u> are required to notify
29	the department immediately to stop all warrants for plate sales
30	if any of the conditions in this section exist, and must meet
31	the requirements of s. 320.08062 for any period of operation
32	during a fiscal year.

37	(a) Upon the National Hispanic Corporate Achievers, Inc.,

41	the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the

44	(b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee
45	shall be distributed to National Hispanic Corporate Achievers,
46	Inc., a nonprofit corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal
47	Revenue Code, to fund grants to nonprofit organizations to
48	operate programs and provide scholarships and for marketing the
49	Hispanic Achievers license plate. National Hispanic Corporate
50	Achievers, Inc., shall establish a Hispanic Achievers Grant
51	Council that shall provide recommendations for statewide grants
52	from available Hispanic Achievers license plate proceeds to
53	nonprofit organizations for programs and scholarships for
54	Hispanic and minority Floridians. National Hispanic Corporate
55	Achievers, Inc., shall also establish a Hispanic Achievers
56	License Plate Fund. Moneys in the fund shall be used by the
57	grant council as provided in this paragraph. All fund received
58	under this subsection must be used in this state.
59	(c) National Hispanic Corporate Achievers, Inc., may retain
60	all proceeds from the annual use fee until documented startup
61	costs for developing and establishing the plate have been
62	recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds from the annual use fee
63	shall be used as follows:
64	1. Up to 10 percent of the proceeds may be used for the
65	cost of administration of the Hispanic Achievers License Plate
66	Fund, the Hispanic Achievers Grant Council, and related matters.
67	2. Funds may be used as necessary for annual audit or
68	compliance affidavit costs.

The remaining proceeds shall be available to the 73 Hispanic Achievers Grant Council to award grants for services, 74 programs, or scholarships for Hispanic and minority individuals 75 and organizations throughout Florida. All grant recipients must 76 provide to the Hispanic Achievers Grant Council an annual 77 program and financial report regarding the use of grant funds. 78 Such reports must be available to the public. 79 (71) VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS LICENSE PLATES.-80 (a) Upon Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Florida, 81 meeting the requirements of s. 320.08053, the department shall 82 develop a Veterans of Foreign Wars license plate as provided in this section. The plates must bear the colors and design 83 84 approved by the department and must incorporate the Great Seal 85 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States as described in Art. VIII, s. 801 of the Congressional Charter and 86 87 By-Laws of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the 88 words "Veterans of Foreign Wars" must appear at the bottom of 89 90 the plate. (b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee 91 92 shall be distributed to Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of 93 Florida, which may retain all of such revenue until the startup 94 costs to develop and establish the license plate program have 95 been recovered. Thereafter, not less than 50 percent of those 96 fees shall be used to support the Voice of Democracy and 97 Patriots' Pen Scholarship programs and to support high school 98 and college ROTC programs. 99
