insert:

Section 2. <u>Whistleblower reward for reporting illegal or</u> improper homestead exemptions.-

(1) Any person may report to his or her local property appraiser's office a possible homestead exemption violation if he or she believes a homestead exemption, as described in s. 196.031, Florida Statutes, has been granted to a person who is not entitled to such exemption. 42 F.S.; creating an exception from the assessment of 43 back taxes on property that was not assessed by a 44 property appraiser; authorizing any person to report to his or her local property appraiser a possible 45 homestead exemption violation under certain 46 47 circumstances; requiring that the property appraiser 48 pay a specified reward to the reporting individual after the recovery of any back taxes or penalties by 49 50 the tax collector; requiring that funds for such 51 reward be taken from a specified source; providing 52 that a reward may be paid to only one person for each 53 verified violation; providing for the determination of the recipient of a reward if more than one resident 54 55 reports a violation; requiring that the Department of 56 Revenue create a form for reporting such violations 57 and provide such form by specified means; requiring that each submitted form contain certain information; 58 59 requiring that the property appraiser stamp each 60 submitted form with the current date and time upon receipt; providing an effective date. 61
