Between lines 73 and 74
insert:

Section 2. Paragraph (q) of subsection (2) of section 499.01, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

499.01 Permits.—

(2) The following permits are established:

(q) *Device manufacturer permit*.—

1. A device manufacturer permit is required for any person that engages in the manufacture, repackaging, or assembly of medical devices for human use in this state, except that a

13 permit is not required if:

14 a. The person is engaged only in manufacturing,
15 repackaging, or assembling a medical device pursuant to a
16 practitioner's order for a specific patient; or-

17 b. The person does not manufacture, repackage, or assemble
18 any medical devices or components for such devices, except those
19 devices or components that are exempt from registration pursuant
20 to s. 499.015(8).

21 ~~2.1-~~ A manufacturer or repackager of medical devices in
22 this state must comply with all appropriate state and federal
23 good manufacturing practices and quality system rules.

24 ~~3.2-~~ The department shall adopt rules related to storage,
25 handling, and recordkeeping requirements for manufacturers of
26 medical devices for human use.
