On Page 397, DELETE Section 97:

SECTION 97. The funding provided in sections 90 through 96 is contingent upon the enactment of federal law which extends the enhanced Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage rate, as provided under the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (P.L. 111-5), from December 31, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

On Page 397, INSERT new Sections 97 and 98:

SECTION 97. There is appropriated \$101,866,986 from the General Revenue Fund and \$134,676,334 from Trust Funds to restore reductions in the Agency for Health Care Administration, the Department of Children and Family Services, and the Department of Health for the 2010-2011 fiscal year.

SECTION 98. The funding provided in sections 90 through 97 is contingent upon the enactment of Senate Bill 1406, or other similar legislation related to taxation, becoming law.
