6 The first \$500,000 of annual use fees shall be (b) 7 deposited in the Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund in the 8 Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and shall be used by 9 the Florida Marine Turtle Protection Program to conduct sea 10 turtle protection, research, and recovery programs. The next 11 \$215,000 in annual use fees shall be distributed to the 12 Caribbean Conservation Corporation to fund sea turtle research 13 and education programs. 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17 research institutions, and coastal counties in this state. The 18 Caribbean Conservation Corporation shall write and publish 19 procedures for submitting grant applications and criteria for 20 allocating available funds, and shall appoint a technical advisory committee, composed of at least five members, including 21 two representatives from the Fish and Wildlife Conservation 22 Commission, to establish funding priorities and select grant 23 24 recipients from proposals submitted by eligible entities. Two of 25 the members shall be selected from the Fish and Wildlife 26 Conservation Commission; one member shall be selected on a 27 rotating biennial basis from a county bordering on the Atlantic 28 Coast with sea turtle nesting sites; one member shall be 29 selected on a rotating biennial basis from a county bordering on the Gulf Coast with sea turtle nesting sites; one member shall 30 be the executive director of the Caribbean Conservation 31 Corporation; and two members shall be selected at large. Any 32 additional annual revenue shall be distributed as follows: 70 33 34 percent shall be deposited in the Marine Resources Conservation 35 Trust Fund and used by the Florida Marine Turtle Protection 36 Program for sea turtle conservation activities and 30 percent 37 shall be assigned to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation for 38 distribution through the Sea Turtle Grants Program. From the 39 funds distributed to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation, an 40 amount not to exceed 10 percent of the total annual revenue from the sale of the plate may be used for marketing the Sea Turtle 41 42 license plate and for administrative costs directly associated 43 with the grants program. A maximum of 15 percent of the funds 44 distributed to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation may be 183763
