Amendment to Amendment (471233) (with title amendment)

Between lines 49 and 50, insert:

(c)1. A county or municipality may not install or cause to be installed traffic infraction detectors pursuant to this act unless such installation is approved in a referendum by the majority of votes cast by those persons eligible to vote in such referendum. Notice of such referendum shall be provided in accordance with s. 100.342. The election costs of the referendum shall be paid in whole out of the county or municipal treasury.

2. The department may not install or cause to be installed traffic infraction detectors in a county or municipality pursuant to this act unless such installation is approved in a referendum by the majority of votes cast by those persons who are eligible to vote in such referendum in the county or

17 municipality in which the traffic infraction detectors are to be
18 installed. Notice of such referendum shall be provided in
19 accordance with s. 100.342. The election costs of the referendum
20 shall be paid in whole by the county or municipality.

21 3. All laws that are applicable to general elections are
22 applicable to elections under this act, except as provided in
23 this act. A county or municipality is not required to offer
24 early voting for a referendum under this act. The places for
25 voting in a referendum under this act shall be the same as the
26 places for voting in general elections when the referendum is
27 held in a county; however, when a referendum under this act is
28 held in a municipality, the polling places shall be the same as
29 in other municipal elections.
