An act relating to standards for drywall; creating s. 553.887, F.S.; directing the Florida Building Commission, in consultation with the Department of Health, to prohibit by rule in the Florida Building Code the use of drywall that exceeds certain limits established for emissions or the content of sulfur or strontium compounds; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 553.887, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

553.887 Drywall emission standards.—The commission, in consultation with the Department of Health, shall adopt a rule in the Florida Building Code establishing emission standards for drywall. The rule shall prohibit the use of drywall that exceeds limits established for emissions or content of sulfur or strontium compounds in drywall used in structures governed by the code. The standard shall be designed to prevent adverse health effects, obnoxious odors, and the corrosion of metal items caused by sulfur or strontium compounds.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
