Section 51. The Legislature recognizes that due to varying local conditions, local governments have different planning needs that cannot be addressed by one uniform set of minimum planning criteria. Therefore, the state land planning agency may amend chapter 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code, to establish different minimum reporting criteria that are applicable to small or fiscally constrained local governments and, based upon the following factors, may establish a waiver provision to satisfy ongoing reporting requirements when no significant changes occur:

- (1) Current and projected population.
