A bill to be entitled

An act relating to heavy equipment rental property; creating s. 196.186, F.S.; authorizing certain rental companies to collect a fee on certain heavy equipment property rentals for certain purposes; providing a limitation; providing a definition; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 196.186, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

An equipment rental company that rents heavy equipment may collect a property tax recovery fee on the rental of such equipment. The purpose of the fee is to allow the company to recover annual tangible personal property taxes imposed upon such equipment and collected. The fee may not exceed the amount of the tangible personal property tax imposed on such property by the county in which the property is located. For purposes of this section, the term "heavy equipment property" means industrial or construction equipment and includes, but is not limited to, equipment described under North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 532412.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
