Subsection (14) is added to section 553.73, Florida Statutes, to read: 553.73 Florida Building Code.-(14) The provisions of section R313 of the most current version of the International Residential Code relating to mandated fire sprinklers may not be incorporated into the Florida Building Code as adopted by the Florida Building Commission and may not be adopted as a local amendment to the Florida Building Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, ordinance, or rule, a single-family dwelling unit may not be required to have fire sprinklers installed regardless of the 23 use or occupancy category of that unit. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
