Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 247 and 248
insert:

Section 4. A unit of local government may not approve the placement of an elevated telecommunications structure that is used for sheltering or mounting antennas, transmitters, receivers, transceivers, digital signal processors, control electronics, GPS receivers for timing, and regular and backup electrical power sources if the proposed location of the structure is on the property of any school that enrolls students in any grade from pre-K through 12 without the written approval of at least 90 percent of all owners of private or public
