- (a) If an applicant desires to practice massage before becoming licensed through examination and completes a course of study at a board-approved massage school, the applicant may apply for a temporary permit in accordance with rules adopted pursuant to this chapter.
- (b) A temporary permit issued by the board is valid for 6 months, until the applicant fails the massage licensure examination, or until the applicant receives a massage license, whichever occurs first.
- (c) An applicant for licensure by examination practicing under a temporary permit may only engage in the practice of massage under the supervision of a licensed massage therapist who holds a valid, active, and unencumbered license.
