Section 4. Paragraph (k) of subsection (3) of section 626.2815, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

626.2815 Continuing education required; application; exceptions; requirements; penalties.-

(3)

10 (k) Any person who holds a license to solicit or sell life 11 insurance in this state must complete a minimum of 3 hours in 12 continuing education, approved by the department, on the subject 13 of suitability in annuity and life insurance transactions. <u>This</u> Florida Senate - 2010 Bill No. CS for SB 844

14	requirement does not apply to an agent who does not have any
15	active life insurance or annuity contracts. In applying this
16	exemption, the department may require the filing of a
17	certification attesting that the agent has not sold life
18	insurance or annuities during the continuing education
19	compliance cycle in question and does not have any active life
20	insurance or annuity contracts. A licensee may use the hours
21	obtained under this paragraph to satisfy the requirement for
22	continuing education in ethics under paragraph (a).
