22	Florida Building Code as adopted by the Florida Building

24	Florida Building Code. This subsection does not apply to a local
25	government that has a lawfully adopted ordinance relating to
26	fire sprinklers which has been in effect since January 1, 2010.

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(11) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (9), a
property owner shall not be required to install fire sprinklers
in any residential property based on the use of such property as
a rental property or any change in or reclassification of the
property's primary use to a rental property.
