29 that position, but the Governor may reject all of the nominees 30 recommended for a position and request that the Board of 31 Governors submit a new list of three different recommended 32 nominees for that position who have not been previously 33 recommended by the Board of Covernors. 34 Three electors, at least one of whom must be a member (b) 35 of a racial or ethnic minority group or a woman, who reside in 36 the territorial jurisdiction of the court or in the circuit, appointed by the Governor; and Five members appointed by the 37 Governor, each of whom is a resident of the territorial 38 39 jurisdiction served by the commission to which the member is 40 appointed, of which at least two are members of The Florida Bar 41 engaged in the practice of law. 42 Three electors, at least one of whom must be a member (C) of a racial or ethnic minority group or a woman, who reside in 43 44 the territorial jurisdiction of the court or in the circuit and who are not members of The Florida Bar, selected and appointed 45 by a majority vote of the other six members of the commission. 46 47 Section 2. If, on July 1, 2010, the composition of a judicial nominating commission does not comply with s. 48 49 43.291(1), Florida Statutes, at least every other appointment to 50 that commission must be a member of a racial or ethnic minority 51 group or a woman until the diversity requirements of s. 43.291(1), Florida Statutes, are satisfied. 52 53 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
