A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Marion County; repealing chapter 85-467, Laws of Florida, relating to municipal service taxing units for road improvements in unincorporated areas and the levying of special assessments within the territorial boundaries of such units; ratifying the levy of such special assessments invalidated or made subject to invalidation for failure to follow requirements of the chapter law prior to its repeal by this act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Chapter 85-467, Laws of Florida, is repealed.

Section 2. The levy of special assessments by the Board of

County Commissioners of Marion County for the purpose of

improving roads in any unincorporated area of the county, which

assessments are invalidated or subject to invalidation for

failure to follow any requirements of chapter 85-467, Laws of

Florida, prior to its repeal by this act, including, but not

limited to, the failure to secure referendum or petition consent

of at least 51 percent of the landowners, is hereby ratified,

validated, and confirmed, and such special assessments are

declared to be legal and valid in all respects.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
