16	replacing the roofs of existing buildings. The study shall
17	include:
18	(a) A summary of available photovoltaic technologies that
19	are suitable for installation on the roofs of buildings.
20	(b) The structural requirements for successful
21	installation and use of photovoltaic technology.
22	(c) The projected cost of installation and maintenance of
23	the technology and the estimated savings from use of the
24	technology to offset the purchase of electricity.
25	(2) Report the findings of the study to the President of
26	the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by
27	March 1, 2011.
