16	designee. Funds allocated to the trust fund include funds
17	received from state appropriations, federal and state grants,
18	and deposits consisting of the monthly systems benefits charge
19	collected by the electric utilities in the state from every
20	residential, commercial, and industrial consumer of electric
21	service for deposit into the trust fund. The funds in the trust
22	fund shall be used to support the activities of the direct-
23	support organization of the office relating to sustainable and
24	renewable energy projects in this state.
